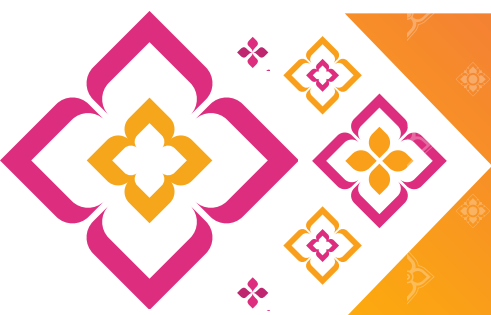
# LET'S BUILD A CONNECTED FUTURE IPSFWC2026

The primary objective of the World Congress is to bring together IPSF members from various countries to discuss and promote the pharmacy and pharmaceutical science professions.

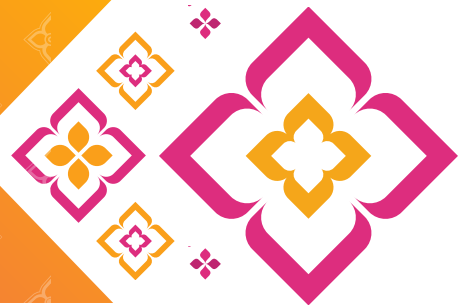

# REGISTRATION TIMELINE

## FURTHER DETAILS

- The **Contact Person Confirmation Letter (CPCL)** is an official document that verifies a registrant's registration category (Official Delegate or Regular Delegate) and **membership status**, as confirmed by the Contact Person.
- For the World Congress, **only the CPCL in the official World Congress template is accepted**. Please contact the Contact Person of your Member Organisation for its issuance.
- Required documents for registration are:
  - Valid identification documents (such as passport or national ID)
  - World Congress Contact Person Confirmation Letter signed by your organisation's contact person.
  - Signed IPSF Code of Ethics and Conduct
  - Signed Terms and Conditions & Waiver of Liability
- Each Member Organisation (MO) is allocated **a quota of three (3) Official Delegates** to attend the IPSF World Congress 2026. As part of the Official Delegates confirmation, registrants must submit the Contact Person Confirmation Letter for **Official Delegate**.
  - The Phase I First wave (Phase 1/1) registration quota is reserved for Official Delegates (ODs) from member organizations.
- If an invitation letter is required, participants must inform during the reservation phase.
- Registration for LiT and PCT is separate from the registration for the Main Congress.
- Separate invoices will be issued for the LiT registration and the PCT package, independent of the IPSF World Congress (Main Congress) invoice.





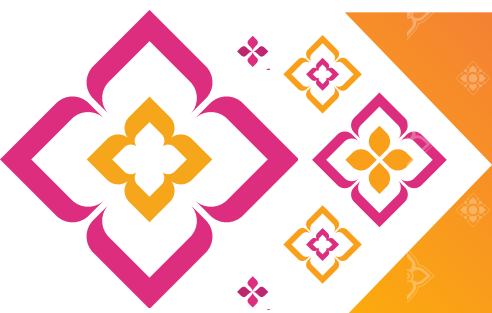
# REGISTRATION PROCESS

## STEP 1: RESERVATION FOR REGISTRATION

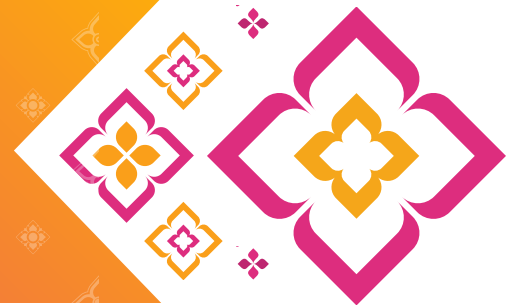
- This stage involves slot reservation and package selection prior to registration, to be completed through the **Reservation for Registration Form**.
- Reservations for the 1st/1 Phase, 1st/2 Phase, and 2nd Phase may close once the quota is full. The 3rd Phase has no quota limit.
- The form for each phase will be available according to the timeline and can be accessed via:
  - 71st IPSF World Congress social media pages
  - 71st IPSF World Congress website
- A **reservation confirmation email** (for those who are allocated a registration slot), together with the attached Registration Form, Invoice, Detailed Payment Information, and a list of required documents for application purposes, will be sent to the email address provided in accordance with the timeline specified for each registration phase.

## STEP 2: REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

- The **Registration Form** and payment must be completed within the designated period according to the timeline.
  - Notes: Additional payment details are available in the Payment section of the Registration Guidelines.
- **Registration and Payment Confirmation** of your registration will be sent to the email address you provide.







# REGISTRATION PROCESS

## IMPORTANT NOTES FOR DELEGATES

1. The 1st - First Wave, 1st - Second Wave, 2nd, and 3rd Phase registrations are applicable **only for the Main Congress**. Registration for **Leaders in Training (LiT)** and the **Post-Congress Tour (PCT)** will be available afterward.
2. Registration for **LiT** and **PCT** is separate from Main Congress. Only **Main Congress registrants** are eligible to register for **PCT**.
3. Delegates **cannot register for PCT alone**.
4. Delegates may register for the following combinations:
  - **LiT only**
  - **Main Congress only**
  - **LiT, Main Congress, and PCT**
  - **LiT and Main Congress**
  - **Main Congress and PCT**
5. **Invitation Letters** will be sent with the registration confirmation email upon request. Requests can be made through the **Registration Form**.
6. **Member organisations** can nominate up to **three (3) current members** to represent them as **Official Delegates**.
7. Registration for the **World Congress** is considered complete upon **payment of registration fees** and **receipt of confirmation**.
8. Domestic delegates may pay the registration fee in **Thai Baht**.

  - The registrant is responsible for the payment of any applicable transaction fees as specified by Wise.
- **Bank transfer:** Secure transfer between banks, available in countries that support the SWIFT network.
  - Registrants are responsible for all bank service or handling fees, which may include outward remittance fees and receiving fees.
    - Outward Remittance Fee
      - International transfer fees differ according to the policies of each financial institution within your country.
    - Receiving fee
      - Individual payment: EUR 6 (approx. THB 200)
      - Group payment: EUR 15 (approx. THB 500)
- In case your local bank charges significant fee for overseas transfers, we would recommend completing payment via Wise.

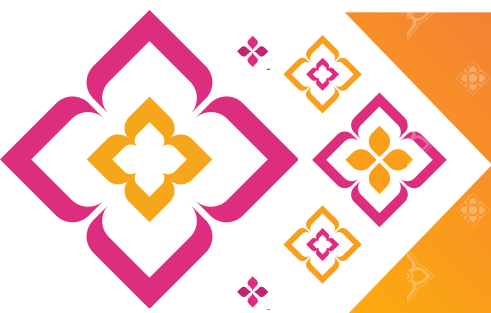

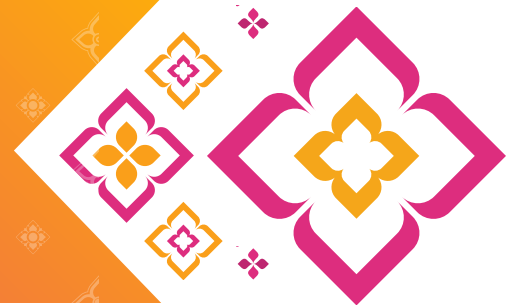
### PROCEDURE

1. Upon submitting the individual reservation for registration form, you will receive a **Reservation Confirmation** email with an **invoice** attachment.
2. The group's representative must contact [regis.ipsfwc2026@gmail.com](mailto:regis.ipsfwc2026@gmail.com) and provide the details of all group members (full names, member organisation, type of delegate, and all individual invoices) within 7 days of receiving the reservation confirmation email. The representative will then receive a **group payment invoice** within 3 days.
  - Subject of the request email: **[Request for Group Payment]**  
**Name Surname**
3. All group members must submit the registration form, by selecting **"Group Payment"**, with the **proof of payment** (Transaction ID and a high-quality scanned PDF of the receipt).
  - File Naming Convention: "Group Payment Proof\_Name of Representative\_Member Organisation\_Country". (eg. Group Payment Proof\_Jirat Injan\_PSAT\_Thailand)
4. After the registration is confirmed. All group members including the representative will receive a **Registration and Payment Confirmation** email individually.

# SLOT REPLACEMENT POLICY

## SLOT REPLACEMENT ELIGIBILITY

Slot replacements are only granted under specific conditions and are subject to the following requirements:

### Valid Reasons

- Registrants must provide a valid reason for the slot replacement request, supported by appropriate documentation
  - Academic commitments (with official proof from the institution)
  - Medical conditions (with doctor's letter or medical report)
  - Other extenuating circumstances (subject to approval)
- Slot replacement requests that do not meet these criteria will not be processed

### Requirements for the Replacement Participant

- The replacement participant must meet all eligibility criteria required for participation in the 71st IPSF World Congress 2026.
- The replacement participant is required to provide the personal information via form provided.





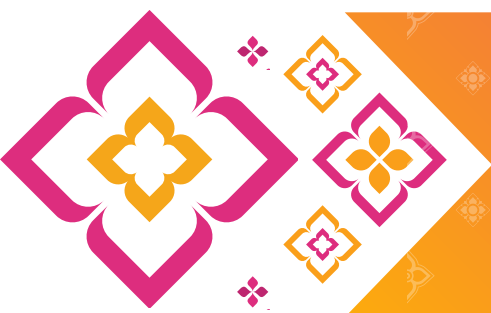
# SLOT REPLACEMENT POLICY

## SLOT REPLACEMENT REQUEST PROCESS

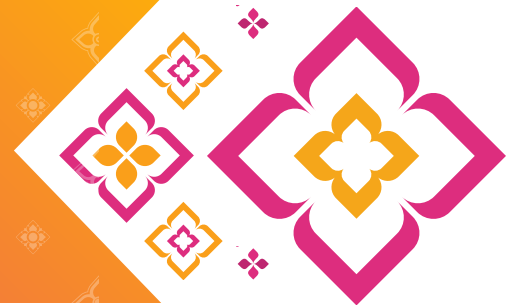
1. Prepare the required documents
  - **Registration Confirmation**
  - **Valid proof**
  - **Replacement participant information, including:**
    - Full name of the replacement participant
    - Member Organisation
    - Delegate type (OD/RD, if applicable)
    - Contact Person Confirmation Letter (CPCL) of the replacement participant
2. Inform the 71<sup>st</sup> IPSF World Congress 2026 Registration Team by sending email to **regis.ipsfwc2026@gmail.com**.
  - a. Kindly use the following subject line: **[Request for Replacement] Name Surname**.
  - b. The email should **clearly state the reason for replacement and include all required supporting documents and replacement participant details**.
3. For the Request to be considered, the submission must **not be later than May 30, 2026**.

## DISCLAIMER

The 71<sup>st</sup> IPSF World Congress 2026 Reception Committee will not be responsible for coordinating, facilitating, or mediating any seat replacement arrangements. All communications, agreements, and logistical matters between the original participant and the replacement participant must be managed independently.







# CANCELLATION POLICY

## REFUND POLICY

If a participant is unable to attend the 71st IPFS World Congress 2026 after completing payment, refunds shall be granted only under specific conditions and must comply with the requirements outlined below.

Period of Cancellation (GMT+7)	Refund Amount
No later than May 15, 2026, at 23.59	75% of total registration fee
No later than May 22, 2026, at 23.59	50% of total registration fee
No later than May 29, 2026, at 23.59	25% of total registration fee
From May 30, 2026 onward	No Refund

## KEY CONDITIONS

- An 80% refund shall be granted in the event of an official visa refusal (applicable only to participants who submit their visa application no later than July 1, 2026), a serious medical condition, or flight cancellation where all flights within the country are cancelled, provided that official supporting documentation is submitted (e.g., visa refusal notice or a doctor's letter/medical report).
- Approval is not guaranteed.
- Any payment made upon arrival shall be non-refundable.

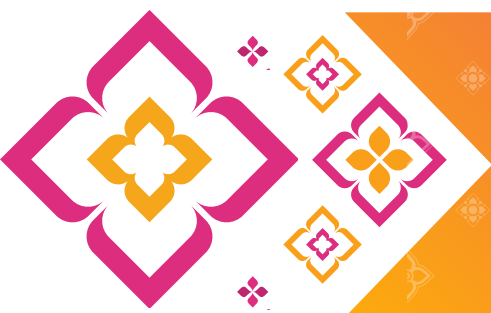
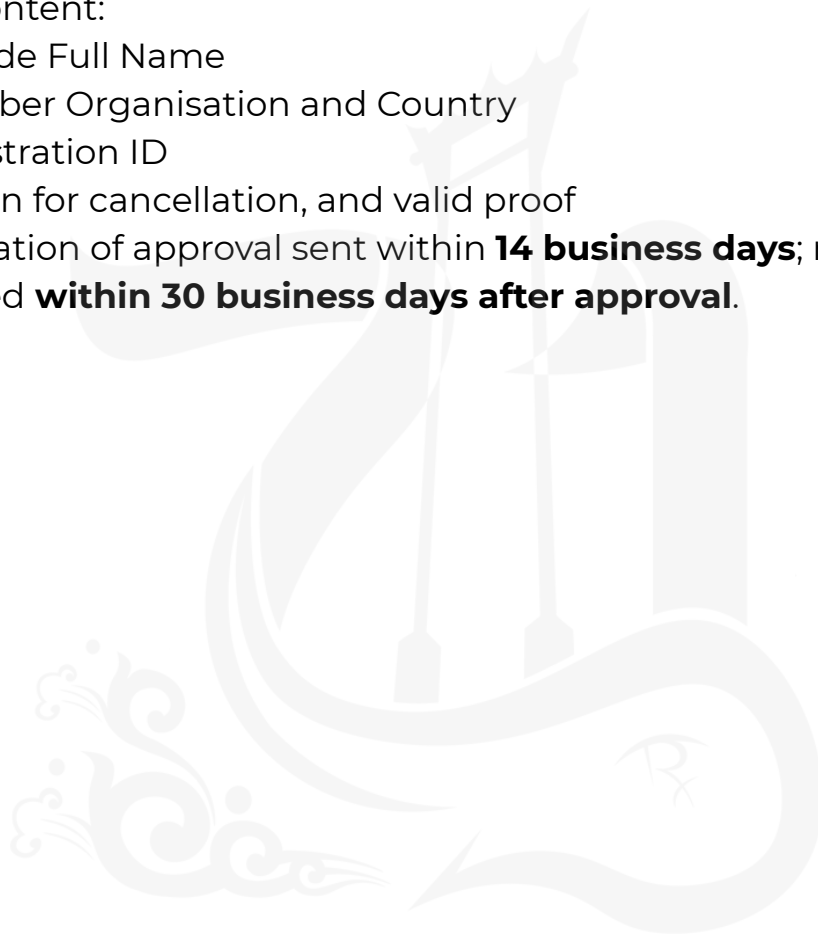

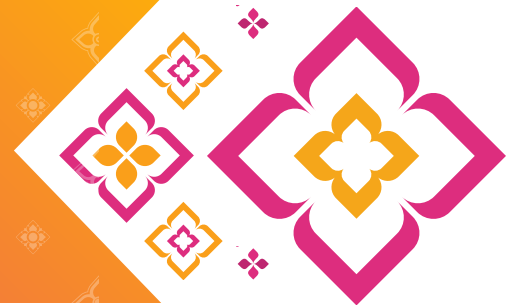
